BE A LIVING REMINDER

Before we can begin there are two words we need to make sure we all understand. They are **testimony** and **boast**.



Imagine you were with Thembi on this windy day... What would you say happened?


Giving all the true facts about what you saw, heard and know happened, would be your **testimony**.

To **boast** is to say how great and how much better something is. The Bible teaches us in

1 Corinthians 1:31 that if we are going to boast let it only be about the **LORD**.

The Israelites were the people that love and follow God. When they saw this box they jumped up and down for joy, cheering, all happy and excited.


DRAW IN THE ISRAELITES

The Philistines were the Israelites enemies who did not love and follow God. When they saw this box they fell on the floor crying, worried and panicked.

DRAW IN THE PHILISTINES

So what is this box and why did the people act so differently when they saw it?

God told Moses to make this special box called the Ark of the Testament, also known as the Ark of the Covenant.



The Ark was seen as the most important object in Israel. It reminded everyone of how great God is. The lid was known as the mercy seat. This is where God would meet with the high priest once a year and the people were forgiven of their sins. **The seat reminded them that God was present.**

Inside the Ark were 3 items.

Aarons rod - This stick was the one that God changed into a snake and that ate all the other snakes (Exodus 7:8-10). It was the one God used to part the red sea. It was also the stick that God made fruit grow on when the tribes of Israel were complaining about who should be in charge. **The rod reminded them that God was powerful, He protected them and led them.**




A jar of manna - Manna was the bread that God had made fall from Heaven to feed the Israelite people when He saved them from Egypt.

The manna reminded them that God looked after them and gave them life.



The stone tablets that God had written all the rules on Himself were also inside. We know them as the 10 commandments. These stones from God reminded them of the promises God had made and how they needed God to be forgiven.



Have you ever thought about what love is?



Let's read what the Bible says love is:

1 Corinthians 13:4 -7 "Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, and it is not proud. ⁵ Love is not rude, it is not selfish, and it cannot be made angry easily. Love is forgiving. ⁶ Love is never happy when others do wrong, but it is always happy with the truth. ⁷ Love never gives up on people. It always trusts, never loses hope, and never quits."

God has given us a promise that no matter what happens in our lives He ALWAYS has a good plan.




This is Morgan and He is going to pretend to be Joseph in our story. Throughout the story colour in his different outfits.

Joseph worked for a man named Potiphar.


Potiphar could see that God gave him success with everything he did and so Potiphar soon put Joseph in charge of the entire house.




THE **CRIMINAL** ON THE CROSS (Luke 23:33,39-43)

One of the criminals hanging on the cross next to Jesus, began to shout insults





The man was forgiven and his heart was filled with peace and joy because he believed in Jesus. He accepted the gift of God's grace right there on the cross.





Think of being on a seesaw... When I boast about all the things I have done, then I lift myself above other people and even God. Bragging and boasting about ourselves makes others feel bad and doesn't lift up God like we should.

James 4:16 says "But now you are proud and you brag. All of this bragging is wrong." (ICB)

The Bible tells us instead to boast about the Lord! When we tell everyone about all the things God has done for us, we lift Him up instead! We can boast about all the gifts He has given us so that we can fulfil the plans He has for our lives because that lifts up God and not ourselves!

1 Corinthians 1:31

"Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord!"


and it would stay like that for 7 years.

Daniel loved God and knew God was not pleased about how the king had been boasting about himself.


Remember that the Bible tells us if we want to boast about anything,

So Daniel told the King that the dream was a warning from God to stop all his boasting and bragging or he would be punished!






Clearly, the king was not too bothered about the warning from God. He continued to be boastful and proud. One day he was walking along, talking about his "great kingdom" and his own "strength".




After the 7 years, the king was very sorry for the way he had been. He gave God all the glory and went back to being the king, only now he was more humble and worshipped God.

Here are a few of the things that his strength from God helped him do.





- He was so strong that he tore a lion to pieces with his bare hands.

Samson was taken prisoner and the Philistines chained him between two pillars in the temple and made fun of him.




But the Philistines had made one big mistake! They had thought Samson's strength came from his hair.



BOAST IN GOD'S PROTECTION

In the Bible, there are lots of stories about God protecting His People... this is the story about Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego .



These three friends had been exiled from Jerusalem by King Nebuchadnezzar. The three friends loved God. They continued to worship Him and serve Him.



Nebuchadnezzar was a very powerful and bossy king. "Everyone must bow down and pray to a big gold statue I have made. If you don't, you will be thrown into a big fiery furnace," said the king.

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego would not bow to the statue. They only worship the One True God.




The king was very angry. "These men must be thrown into the fiery furnace," he said.



They said, "If you throw us into the hot furnace, the God we serve can save us. But even if God does not save us, we want you to know, King, we will not

worship the gold idol you have set up."

The king's soldiers threw the three friends into the fire. It was very hot but it didn't burn them! God protected them! Not even their clothes got burnt!



The king looked into the furnace and said "Look! I see four men walking around in the fire. They are not tied up and they are not burned. The fourth man looks like the son of God."

The king called them out of the fire. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego had trusted God to protect them and He did. The king even made a new rule that no one must say anything against God.







BOAST IN GOD'S HEALING



Sometimes we or someone we love gets sick.

But the Bible says in Matthew 8:17

"He took our sickness and removed our diseases."

That means that when Jesus died on the cross, not only did He take our sins upon Himself but also our sicknesses!

We can pray and have faith that Jesus will heal us.

Sometimes God chooses not to heal. That can be really hard for us to understand but remembering how much He loves us, how great His plans are for us and how perfect He is can help us to keep our faith in Him strong.

Here are 3 testimonies from the Bible of people Jesus healed. Look how much they teach us about boasting that Jesus is our healer.

1) The Centurion (Matthew 8: 5-11)

"I heard that Jesus was in Capernaum. One of my young servants was in bed paralyzed and in pain. I went to Jesus and told Him all about my servant. Jesus immediately said that He would come to my house and heal the servant. But I told Jesus that He didn't need to come all the way to my house. He has authority just like me! When I tell someone to do something, they do it! And so, if Jesus just said that my servant would be healed, I knew that he would be!"



2) *The lady with the blood issue (Mark 5:24-34)*




BOAST IN GOD'S WISDOM

The Bible tell us about a man named Solomon. It says he was the wisest man that ever lived. He was one of the kings of Israel.



Solomon loved God and he showed his love for God by making many sacrifices. This pleased God.

One night, God appeared to Solomon in a dream and said, ***"What do you want? Ask, and I will give it to you!"***




Solomon didn't ask for riches or power or victory over his enemies, although he could have. Solomon wanted to be a good king to God's people. He wanted to rule them well. For that, he needed to be wise.

Solomon understood that true treasure is God's wisdom. He recognised that only God is wise, and that only God could give him wisdom to be a great king. Proverbs 2:6 says that "the Lord grants wisdom! From his mouth come knowledge and understanding."


God was pleased that Solomon had asked for wisdom so God said, "I will give you what you asked for! I will give you a wise

God blessed Solomon with heavenly wisdom, not man's wisdom. People heard how wise and fair King Solomon was and that he knew what was right and what was wrong. They came to hear the wise words God gave him.

And because Solomon didn't ask for riches, or anything for himself, God also made him a very rich man. God blessed King Solomon.
