





The disciples of JESUS

Jesus calls us to follow Him

“Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will make you fishers of men.”

Matthew 4:19














Andrew brings others to Jesus


“Go into all the world and preach the good news to everyone.

- 🐟 **I denied three times that I was a friend of Christ (Matt 26:69-75)**
- 🐟 **God sent an angel to set me free when King Herod put me in prison (Acts 12:11)**

Mark 2:17




- **Jesus called me as an apostle to be an eyewitness to His ministry & to preach what He taught me. (Mark 3:14-19)**




What you will need:


Nathanael (Bartholomew)




