




JESUS TURNED WATER TO WINE

JESUS HEALED THE OFFICIAL'S SON

(John 4:46-53 NLT)


⁴⁶ As He, Jesus, traveled through Galilee, He came to Cana, where He had turned the water into wine. There was a government official in nearby Capernaum whose son was very sick. ⁴⁷ When He heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, He went and begged Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal His son, who was about to die.



⁴⁸ Jesus asked, "Will you never believe in Me unless you see miraculous signs and wonders?"

⁴⁹ The official pleaded, "Lord, please come now before my little boy dies."

⁵⁰ Then Jesus told him, "Go back home. Your son will live!"



And the man believed what Jesus said and started home.

While the man was on his way, some of his servants met him with the news that his son was alive and well. ⁵² He asked them when the boy had begun to get better, and they replied, "Yesterday afternoon at one o'clock his fever suddenly disappeared!"



⁵³ Then the father realized that that was the very time Jesus had told him, "Your son will live." And he and his entire household believed in Jesus.







Read John 6:1-15




Jesus had been teaching and doing many miracles and so a huge crowd kept following Him. They wanted to see what would happen next.

Jesus then turned to His disciple, Philip, and asked Him "Where can we buy bread to feed all these people?"





Look at the cartoon below and draw what you think will happen next...



Sometimes we can guess what is going to happen next but we can never know for sure. Jesus, on the other hand, always knows what is going to happen.

The Bible tells us in John 6:6 that Jesus knew what He was going to do next, even before He asked Philip this question.



And what did Jesus do next? A boy offered his small lunch to Jesus. Jesus took the lunch of only 2 fish and 5

loaves, gave thanks to God and He made it be enough food to feed 5000 men and their families.



There were even 12 baskets of food left over!



We all know that we need food to stay alive. Without food we would have no life.

Soon after this miracle Jesus used the idea of needing bread to explain that we need Him to have eternal life.



He did this by telling them how to have eternal life...

Jesus said: "I am the \_\_\_\_\_ of life!"

Jesus gave us this eternal life when He did the most generous miracle of all. He died for our sins on the cross. But do you remember what He did next? Yes, Jesus came alive again and is still alive right now! And only by believing in Jesus are we forgiven and can have eternal life with Him.

John 9

One day Jesus and His disciples saw a blind man. "Is this man blind because he or his parents were bad?" asked one of the disciples.



"Neither," Jesus answered. "But to show the power of God."



Jesus then spat on the ground and mixed some clay together before putting it on the blind man's eyes. "Go and wash in the pool of Siloam," Jesus told the man.

The man obeyed Jesus and made his way to the pool. He washed in the pool and he was healed of his blindness. He could see again!




Some who knew the man were amazed that he could see. Some did not believe it. But the man said, "Yes, I am the man who was blind!"



John 11: 1-45.

Jesus went to the tomb and He shouted, "Lazarus, come out!"


**And Lazarus came alive!**

Yes! It was just like Jesus had said it would be. Many gave God glory and believed.




Spot 8 differences between the two pictures.

This story is about the love Jesus has for us and the way He looks at us. Matthew 26:36-56

Before Jesus was crucified, He went to pray. Jesus was so very afraid because He knew it would be the first time that He would have sin and separation from the Father.



Jesus didn't want to suffer this painful death and asked God if there was another way for people to be saved from their sin. But He also prayed that **God's will would be done** and not His own.



When the officials came to arrest Jesus, Peter tried to defend Him by pulling out his sword and cutting off the ear of one of the men.

Do you think Jesus needed Peter to defend?





In Matthew 26:53-54 Jesus said to Peter,

“Do you think I cannot call on my Father and He will at once put at my disposal more than 12 legions of angels? But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen in this way?”

Jesus knew that He was going to be killed and He had the authority to call upon the angels and be rescued, but He chose to stay. The love that Jesus has for me and you meant that He willingly chose to die. Jesus knew that His death would be the perfect sacrifice for us to be forgiven of all our sins.

Jesus touched the servant's ear and healed him. What a miracle! A man that was an enemy of Jesus! A man that was even there to arrest him so that He would be put to death! **But Jesus showed him love.**




We are a bit like that servant. We make bad choices and we hurt Jesus, but He loves us. More than 2000 years before we were born and before we made any bad choices, Jesus chose to die for us so that we can be forgiven.

Romans 5:8 tells us:

“For while we were still sinners Christ died for us.”

There is nothing we can do that is too bad for Jesus to forgive. He has already done the most incredible miracle of dying and coming back to life. A miracle that means we don't have to be separated from God. A miracle that no one else could do. **A miracle of love!**
