²⁴ “He is the God who made the world and everything in it. Since He is Lord of heaven and earth, He doesn’t live in man-made temples, ²⁵ and human hands can’t serve His needs—for He has no needs. He Himself gives life and breath to everything, and He satisfies every need. ²⁶ From one man He created all the nations throughout the whole earth. He decided beforehand when they should rise and fall, and He determined their boundaries. ²⁷ “His purpose was for the nations to seek after God and perhaps feel their way toward Him and find Him—though He is not far from any one of us. ²⁸ For in Him we live and move and exist. As some of your own poets have said, ‘We are His offspring.’ ²⁹ And since this is true, we shouldn’t think of God as an idol designed by craftsmen from gold or silver or stone. ³⁰ “God overlooked people’s ignorance about these things in earlier times, but now He commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins and turn to Him. ³¹ For He has set a day for judging the world with justice by the man He has appointed, and He proved to everyone who this is by raising Him from the dead.”

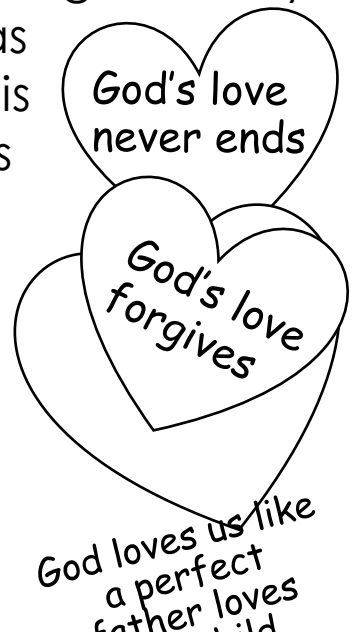
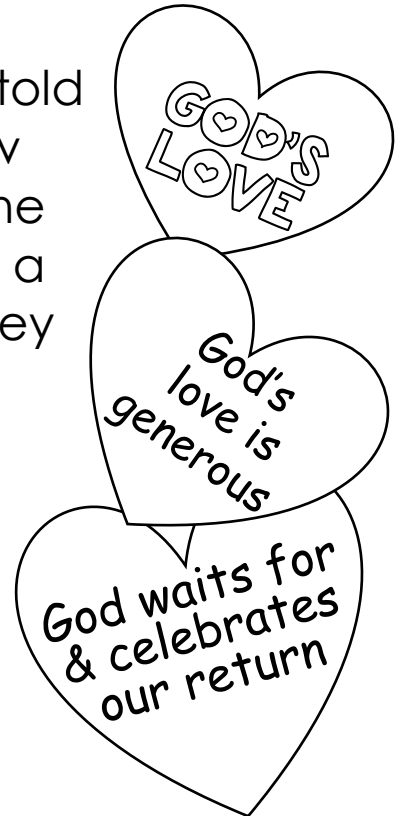
How have you shown love to God?

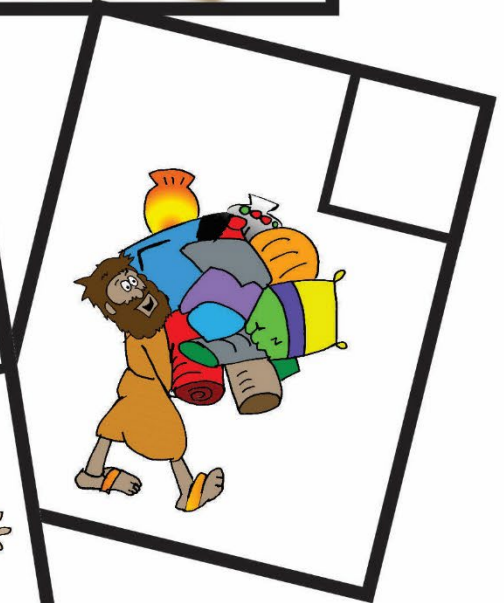
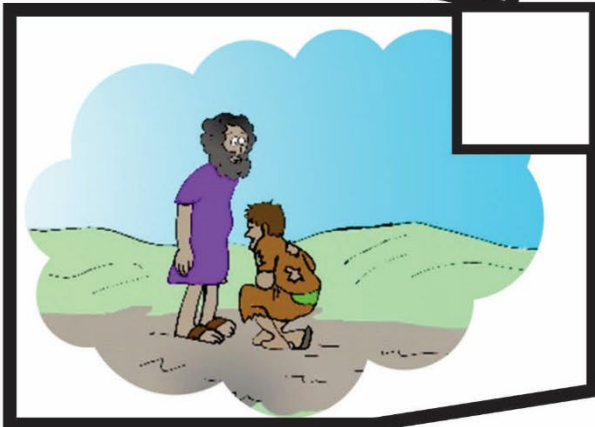
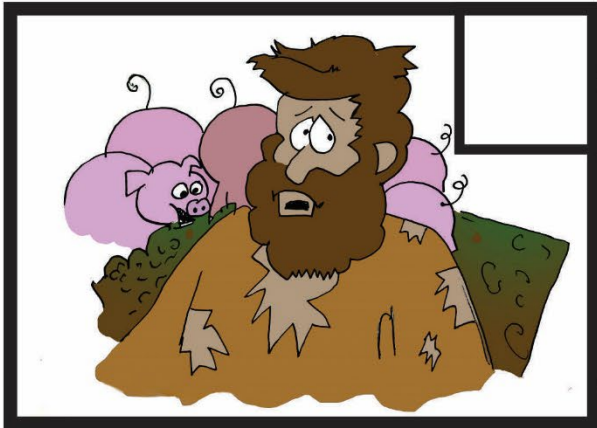
Jesus told the following story: Luke 15:11-24

¹¹ "A man had two sons. ¹² The younger son told his father 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' **So his father agreed.** Then the son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land and there he wasted all his money in wild living. ¹⁴ About the time his money ran out a great famine swept over the land and he began to starve. ¹⁵ He persuaded a local farmer to hire him and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. ¹⁶ The young man became so hungry that even the pig food looked good to him. But no one gave him anything. ¹⁷ "When he finally came to his senses he said to himself 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare and here I am dying of hunger! ¹⁸ I will go home to my father and say "Father I have sinned against both heaven and you ¹⁹ and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."²⁰ "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion he ran to his son embraced him and kissed him. ²¹ His son said to him 'Father I have sinned against both heaven and you and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'²² "But his father said to the servants

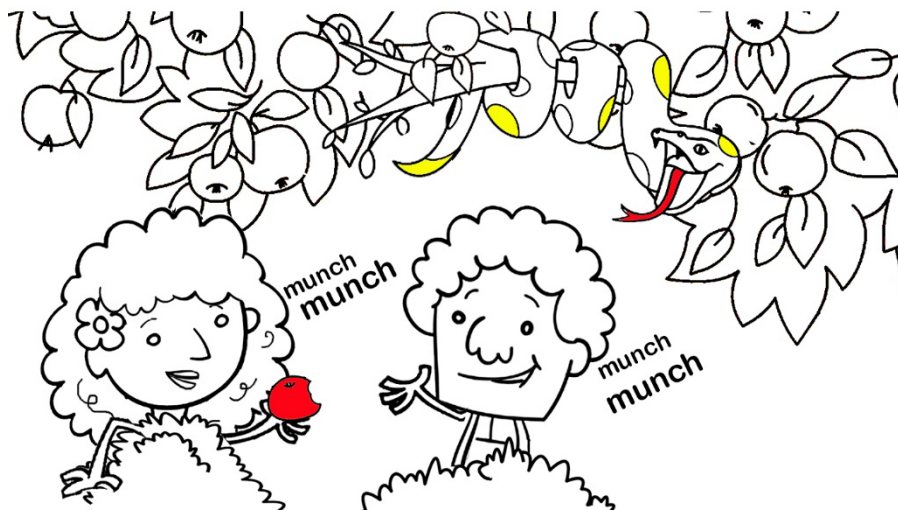

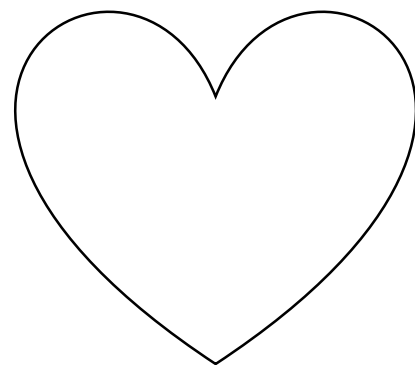
SAVED FOREVER



Sin entered the world at the moment Adam and Eve chose to listen to the serpent and eat from the tree that God had told them not to. Read the story in *Genesis 3*.

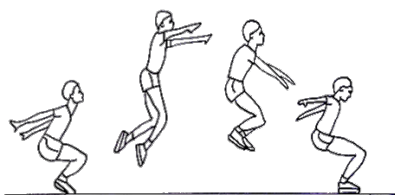

“No one is righteous— not even one.

Romans 3:23 ²³ For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.



GOD'S GLORY

Our sin separates us from being with God. No matter how hard we try we **CANNOT** meet God's standard on our own.

The price we should pay for sinning is death or separation from God forever... **BUT**... God instead gave us a free gift. Through Jesus we are given the gift of eternal life!



Romans 6:23 ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

And this free gift isn't given to us once we do everything right. It is given while we are sinners.

Romans 5:8 ⁸ But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.



This free gift is **J E S U S** dying in our place for our sins so that we can be forgiven.

Romans 10:9-10 ⁹ If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

SAVED FOREVER (Baptism)

Before Jesus had started His ministry He went to the Jordan river and asked John to baptise Him. John immediately recognised that Jesus was the one God had promised would come to save the world and so he tried to talk Jesus out of it. He thought it was better for Jesus to baptise him instead! Let's read what Jesus replied.



Matthew 3:15 ¹⁵ But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So John agreed to baptize Him. ¹⁶ As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him. ¹⁷ And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased."

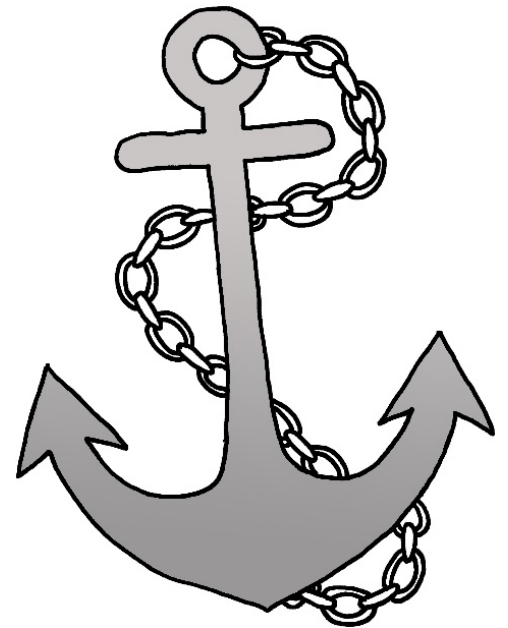

HOPE

God loves us so much that He chose for His son, Jesus, to die for our sin. This was a gift from God. Nothing we do, can give us this gift or take this gift away. Once we have chosen to believe in Jesus we are *saved*. Being saved means we have a confident hope and expectation that one day we will live with God in Heaven forever.

When the anchor is down the sailor doesn't have to worry about sailing the ship. He knows he can trust the anchor to keep the ship in one place. Hebrews 6:19 explains the hope we have in being with God, is like a strong and trustworthy anchor.

The Bible is one of the many ways we can find God. We don't just learn information about Him, He actually reveals Himself to us.

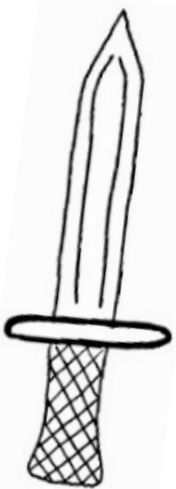
The Bible makes my mind new.

We need to fill our thoughts with God's thoughts and not with other people's opinions. The Bible helps us do this.

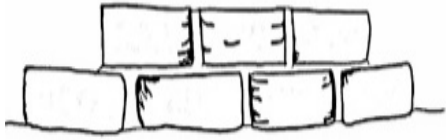
The Bible helps me stand against evil plans.

God uses the Bible to show us the sin in our hearts and amazingly, He helps us be more like Him.

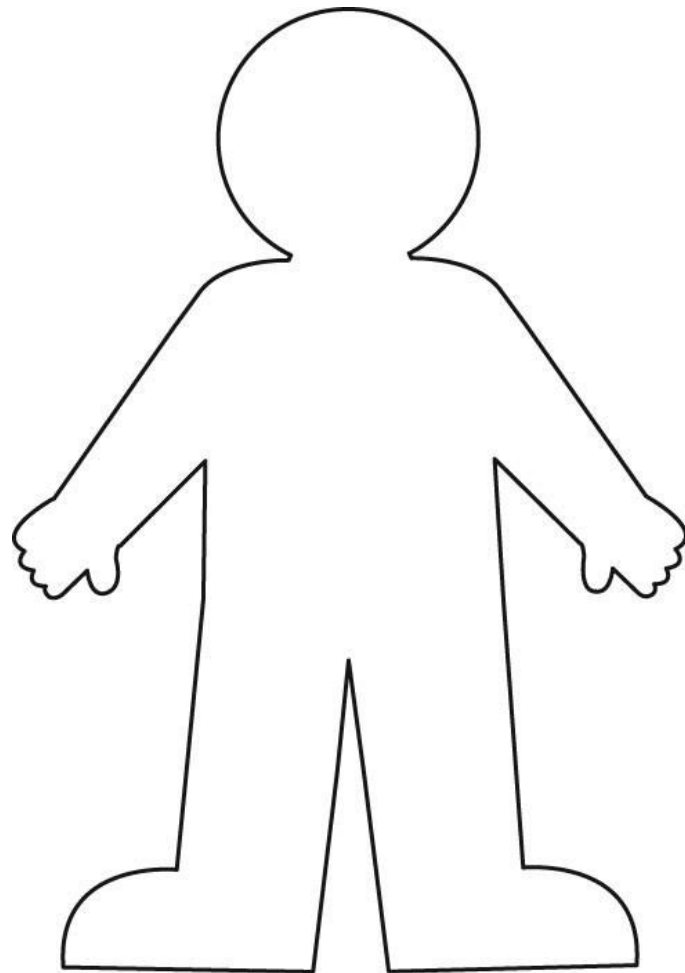
The Bible helps me not sin.

JOINING THE MISSION

Many people do not know how wonderful God is nor that Jesus is the only way to Heaven. God doesn't want to force them to believe. Instead He chooses us to show others how great He is. 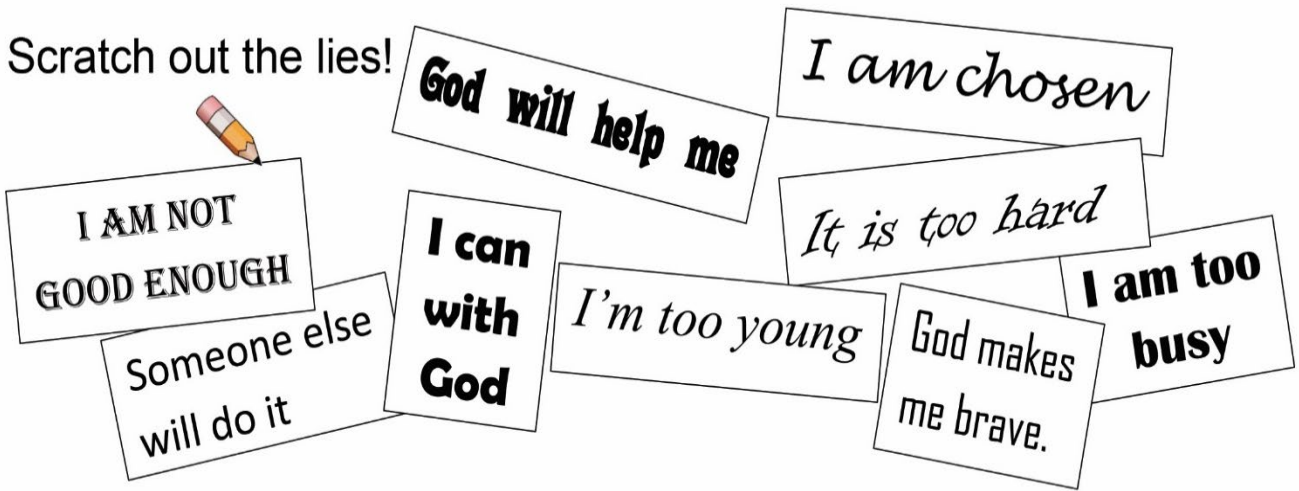

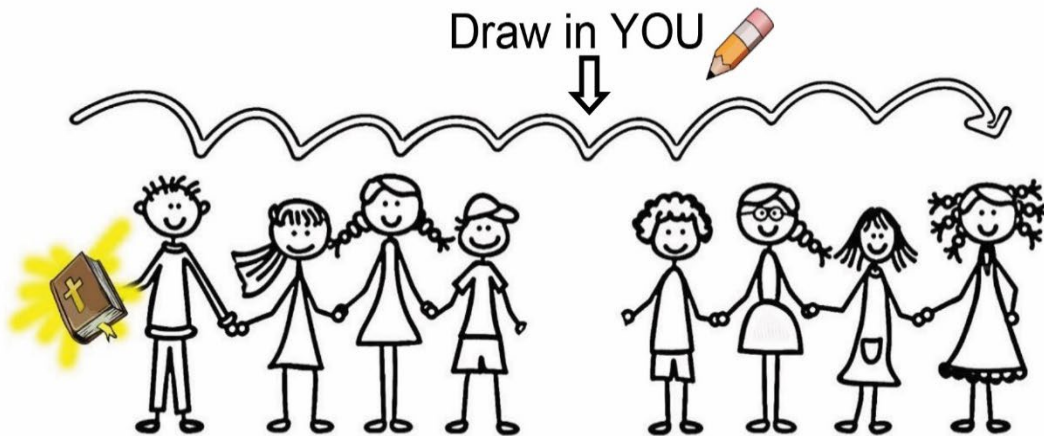

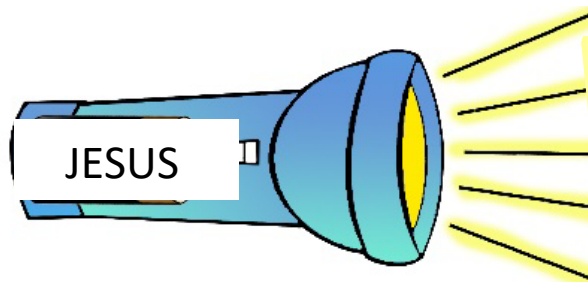
