Jesus is the potter and we are the clay.

11 "A man had two sons. 12 The younger son told his father 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' So his father agreed.



*A share of the estate is only given once a father dies so by the son asking for it now it was like he was saying "I wish you were dead". But the father showed the son love by giving it to him when he asked.*

God shows us love by giving us everything we need. (Acts 17:25)



Then the son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land...



*It was the son who chose to leave and NOT the father sending him away.*

God's love is always there. It is us who move away from Him and choose to not to accept and experience His love.

... and there he wasted all his money in wild living.



*Wild living is not how the father would have wanted the son to live but he showed love by letting his son make his own choices.*

God shows us love by letting us make our own choices. (Joshua 24:15)  
Of course like the son in the parable there are consequences to our poor choices.

<sup>14</sup> About the time his money ran out a great famine swept over the land and he began to starve. <sup>15</sup> He persuaded a local farmer to hire him and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. <sup>16</sup> The young man became so hungry that even the pig food looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.



*The son only realised the benefit and love of being with the father when he was away.*

God's love for us never changes, no matter where we are or what we do. Be thankful for the blessing and protection you receive from, don't let disobedience make you realise what you had.



17 "When he finally came to his senses he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare and here I am dying of hunger! 18 I will go home to my father and say, "Father I have sinned against both heaven and you 19 and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."'"



*The son knew he had done something. He knew he had to ask for forgiveness. His actions did deserve the father to not treat him as a son.*

Remember to ask God to forgive you. Asking forgiveness is not what makes us a son or daughter but it is definitely what God deserves since we have sinned against Him.

20 "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion he ran to his son embraced him and kissed him. 21 His son said to him 'Father I have sinned against both heaven and you and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'



*The father waited for the sons return and hugged and kissed him and immediately forgave him when he did.*

God celebrates when we choose to believe in Him and ask for forgiveness and He is quick to forgive. Even our sin does not stop God from loving us.

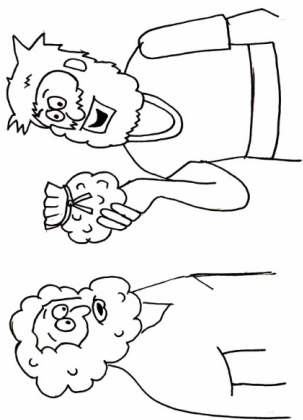

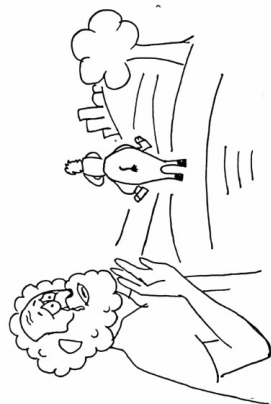


*Nothing stopped the father from his love for his son. To him he could never be a slave. The father celebrated the **son's** return.*

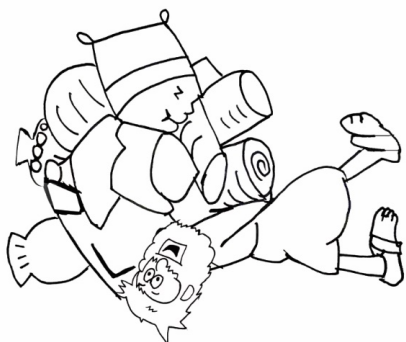

1 John 4:19 "We love Him because He loved us first."

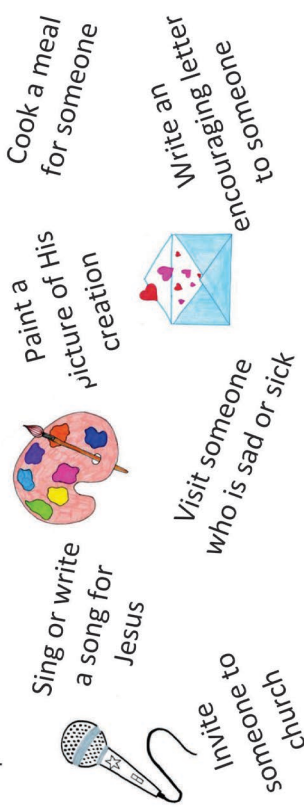


*Worship* is our *response* to God's love and mercy for us!

Cook a meal for someone



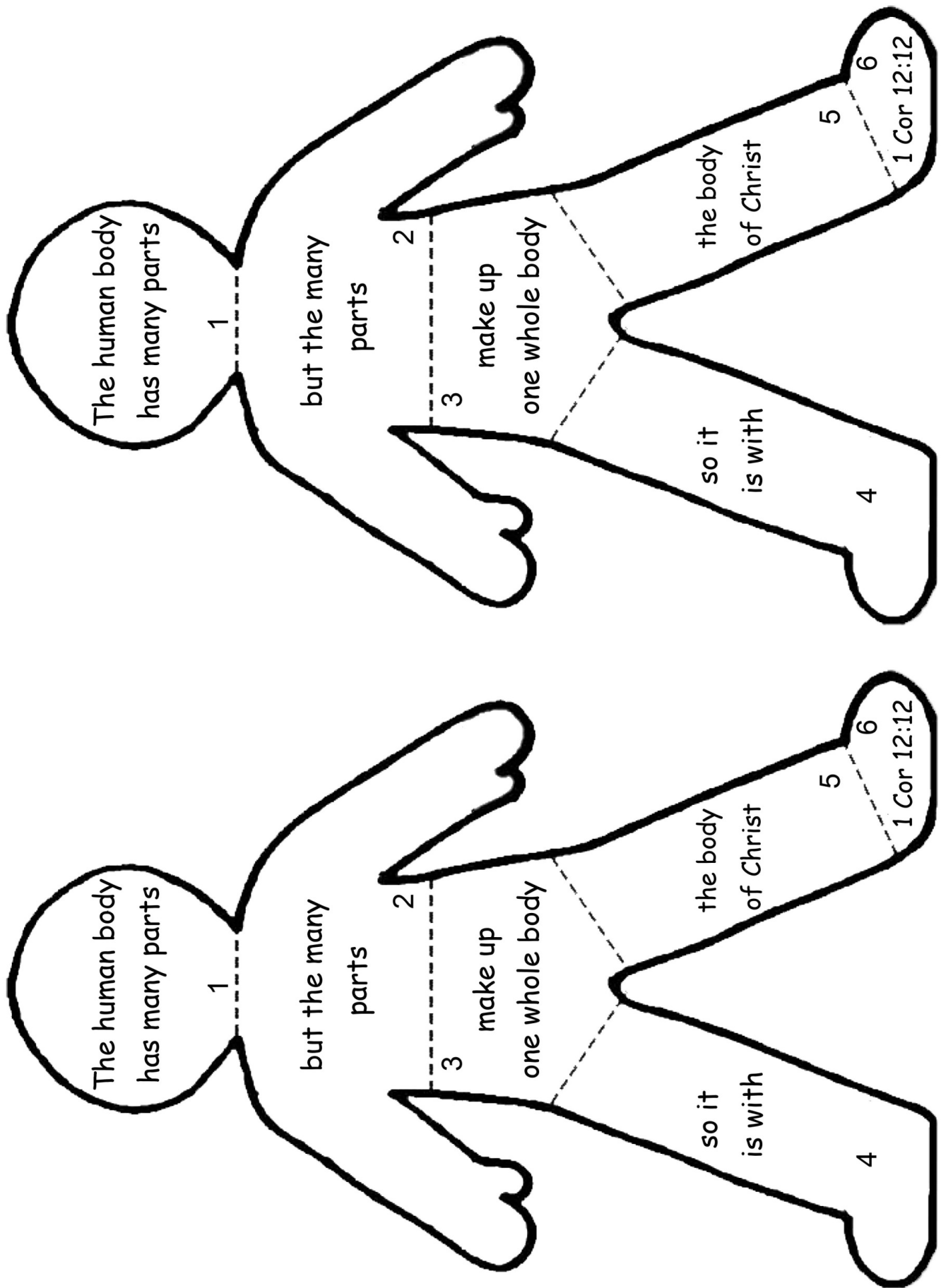
