

Craft Dice!

(The Ten Plagues of Egypt)

Lesson Idea:

Children love playing games so why not help them make their own craft dice to remind them about how God sent the plagues to Egypt to show everyone in Egypt, including Pharaoh, that God is the one and only God!

After teaching the story of the plagues and how God freed the Israelite people from Egypt, let children make their own. They can use their dice to retell the story and to see if they can remember them all!

You could pair the dice with a simple game board where after rolling the dice, you may only move if you can remember which plague is on the dice or even the verse that went with it.

Items needed per child:

- A dice template
- Glue
- scissors


Craft making instructions:

1. Cut around the outside of the template, not on the inner lines
2. Fold along the inner lines to form the shape of a cube.
3. Put glue on the tabs to hold the dice together. Little ones will need help.


