

Find your puzzle!

Lesson Idea:

You can use this ice-breaker to introduce children to the verse or theme you will be learning. It is also a great reminder that each of us have a part to play - with even one piece missing, the puzzle is just not complete.

Items needed:

- Laminated and cut posters (these could have a verse on them or be theme specific)
- 1 poster puzzle piece per child (Cut the posters in 6-10 pieces)

Game instructions:

1. Give each child a piece of a poster. This is their puzzle piece.
2. The children have to go around and find the children with the puzzle pieces that belong with their piece.
3. Once the children have found all their pieces, they must work together to build the poster puzzle.
4. The first group to build their poster puzzle are the winners.

Mark the pieces with a colored dot or a number. Tell the children how many pieces belong to their poster puzzle.
