


Jesus calls us to follow Him

Who are people you can tell about Jesus?
















Andrew brings others to Jesus


"Go into all the world and preach the good news to everyone.

- ☐ Jesus called me as an apostle to be an eyewitness to His ministry and to preach what He taught me (Mark:14-19)
- ▶ I was the first disciple to openly say that Jesus is the Christ, the son of the living God (Matt 16:16)
- ▶ I was present at the transfiguration of Jesus(Matt 17:1-9)
- ▶ I walked on water to Jesus (Matt 14:29)
- □ I drew my sword and cut off the ear of the high priest's servant when they arrested Jesus (John 18:10)
- □ I denied three times that I was a friend of Christ (Matt 26:69-75)
- God sent an angel to set me free when King Herod put me in prison (Acts 12:11)

One lesson we can learn from Peter is that there will be times when we get it all right. We follow Jesus well, we tell others about Him and we have faith.

There will also be times when we get it all WRONG!




- •Jesus called me as an apostle to be an eyewitness to His ministry & to preach what He taught me. (Mark 3:14-19)

Did you know we are sinners too. There is only one way our sins can be forgiven and that is through **Jesus**!






- Desus called us as disciples to be an eyewitness to His ministry and to preach what He taught. (Mark 3:14-19)




Thomas stops doubting and believes

Did the balloon inflate?


You can't see the gas so how do you know it's there?

 - Jesus knew me before he met me and said I was a man "in whom there is nothing false" (John 1:47)



Jesus knows me


Lord, you have tested me, so you know all about me.


James (the less)

Simon the zealot


- ▶ I was a zealot ... a military person that fought against the Roman laws to declare God was their king.


