
It is impossible for us to count all the grains of sand in the world but God can and that is how many times **He thinks about you!**


God made the whole world and is so great that He holds it in His hands. This great Father thinks about you, knows everything about you and wants you to be His child. WOW!





Yes Eli. How can I help you Eli? What? You didn't call me?




Yes Eli? What do you need? Huh? Eli said he didn't call me.






God knows your name and has a special message just for you.

I listened to God that day and anointed the small shepherd boy, David, to one day be king. God's choice was much better than mine because David turned out to be a great king.






Lesson 3: GOD BY YOUR SHEPHERD

In the Bible, David wrote a Psalm about God being our Shepherd. Let's have a look at Psalm 23 and see all the things our good shepherd does for us.






When we have chosen to follow Him, these are things we should do:




We need to <u>**READ**</u> God's word, the Bible. We can learn all about God and how to live for Him.

Then we need to <u>FOLLOW</u> God by going where He leads us.



Moses was a great man. God used him to do many amazing things for God's people. Here are just a few of the amazing things Moses did:

You can read all about it in the book of Exodus in the Bible.

God used Moses to



free the people of Israel from the evil

Pharaoh who was keeping them as slaves. He warned Pharaoh about God's power.

3 Moses lead the people



through the desert. God provided for the people in miraculous

ways. He gave them water from a rock, food from heaven and directions in the form of a cloud.

2 After Moses lead the

people out of Egypt, he lifted his staff and God parted the



Red Sea so that the people could walk though it to get away from the soldiers.


4 God met with Moses up on



the mountain and gave him the Ten Commandments.

These were the rules God wanted the people to live by. Moses then took them to the people.

But did you know that at the beginning Moses didn't believe that he could do anything great for God? He made all sorts of excuses about why he wasn't good enough! Here's what happened... Moses was living in the Pharaoh's palace where he grew up but hated the way the Egyptian people treated the Hebrew people.





Hebrew slave. He had to run away from the palace and hide in the desert. The Hebrew people were still slaves in Egypt and they cried out to God to free them. Even though Moses ran away, GOD STILL HAD A PLAN FOR HIM!



One day, Moses saw a burning bush. It was God, telling him that he needed to go back to Egypt and free His people. But Moses kept giving God excuses about why he couldn't be the one to carry out this

big job that God had for him.

In Exodus 3:11 Moses says that he did not feel that he was good enough. He spent a long time arguing with God.





In Exodus 3:13 he says that he doesn't have all the answers. And again in

Exodus 4:1 he argues that no one will listen to him.





In Exodus 4:10 he even tells God that he is a terrible public speaker and in verse 13 he says: "I'm not qualified, send someone else."

Moses made all these excuses because he didn't believe he was able to do what God asked.

BUT GOD HAD A PLAN FOR MOSES!

God didn't need Moses to be a good public speaker or have all the answers. He only needed Moses to be willing and obedient.


DISASTER PIECE. HE HAS CREATED



Lesson 5: GOD GIVES YOU EVERYTHING YOU LIED TO DO WHAT HE CALLS US TO DO.

The Bible tells us of a young man named Jeremiah. He actually has a whole book written about him. God gave Jeremiah a very special job to do, but he didn't think that he could do it.



Let's read how Jeremiah's story began.

God spoke to Jeremiah and said:



"Before I made you in your mother's womb, I knew you. Before you were born, I chose you for a special work. I chose you to speak to the nations for me."

How wonderful is that? God told Jeremiah that He knew him and that He made him.

Do you know that God knows you too? He made you! He knows everything about you. Just like Jeremiah, God chooses each one of you for a special work too!

How do you think Jeremiah felt about being chosen to speak God's words to the nations?




Jeremiah was about 17 years old when God gave him his special work. Jeremiah thought that he was too young to speak to the nations. Jeremiah didn't feel like he was ready.

But that's not what God thought.
God said: "Don't say, 'I am only
a boy.' You must go everywhere
I send you and say everything I
tell you to say. Don't be afraid
of anyone. I am with you, and I
will protect you."



Then the Lord reached out with His hand and touched my mouth.



He said to me, "Jeremiah, I am putting my words in your mouth.

Today I have put you in charge of nations and kingdoms. You will pull up and tear down. You will destroy and overthrow. You will build up and plant."

Even though Jeremiah was young, God used Him. Jeremiah didn't think that he was ready to be used by God, but God made him ready. God gave Jeremiah everything he needed to get the job done. He gave Jeremiah the instructions and all the right tools. So Jeremiah set off to speak God's words. Whatever God told him to say came true.




ARE YOU READY TO DO GOD'S PLAN FOR YOU?

Read the sentences below and colour in the pictures of the tools God gives us to do the job.


- 1. God wants us to love Him and people. We can do this because He loved us first. (1 John 4:19)

God told Elijah to go and hide in a place where he would have water to drink. God also told Elijah that ravens (birds) would bring food to him. Do you think Elijah trusted God

But one day, because there hadn't been any rain, the stream dried up and Elijah didn't have any water left!

Every day there was enough flour and oil to make the food they needed.


Elijah always obeyed and trusted God to provide for his needs.

with Jesus. He even tried to stop the soldiers from arresting Jesus.




Jesus told Peter that he would deny knowing Him three times!

 - What does it look like Judas has in his heart?




Jesus' disciples followed and talked with Jesus every day.


This verse is saying that when we are sorry for what we have done God wants us to tell Him about these wrong things and then He will forgive us.





A lot of people in the world do not know about the love of Jesus and the family they can be a part of.





That's why we need to show people around us the love of Jesus through the way that we love each other.






In the Bible, Jesus is also called Immanuel. Immanuel means "God with us". When Jesus was on earth, He was God, the Son, with us on earth.



In the book of Genesis from chapter 6 to chapter 10, we read about a man named **Noah**. He was a man who worshiped **God**.




God said to Noah, 'It is going to rain and rain. Build a big boat

At last the day came when everyone could go outside again! Noah and his family thanked God for keeping them safe and dry.


God then made a promise that He would never send such a big flood again. He gave a special reminder about His promise.




