

# Mazes!

## Lesson Idea:

Having a big open space available is a great place to set up a maze. Mazes fit in with almost every theme you could think of. Mazes are also a way to reinforce memory verses.

E.g. *Isaiah 30:21*

*Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."*

Mazes need to be prepared in advance and leaders need to control the kids entering the maze. You may want to put leaders inside the maze to direct kids through.

## Items needed:

- Rope, danger tape, flags, poles, or boxes (anything that can mark out a maze route)
- Items for the kids to collect. (e.g. laminated words of a bible verse, coins, pegs or pieces of a puzzle)
- Blindfolds (optional)

## Game instructions:

1. Children take turns making their way through the maze, collecting items as they go through. You could divide the children into teams. Each team is assigned a colour and the collectable items are colour coded.
2. As the kids exit the maze, they could say a verse and drop their items into the box.
3. Once all the kids have taken a turn in the maze, they could then get together use the collected items to build a puzzle.
4. You could add blindfolds if you wish to. One team member is in the maze while a partner directs them through.
