

# True or false!

## Lesson Idea:

The Bible is filled with verses that remind us that Jesus is the truth (*John 14:6*), the Holy Spirit guides us to the truth (*John 16:13*) and in fact that God cannot lie (*Hebrew 6:18*). After playing this game, spend some time with the children going through the common lies they get trapped in, teaching them Bible verses so they have the truth in their hearts or doing a fun Bible quiz after the story you teach that day.

## Game instructions:

1. Divide the playing area into 2 sides.
2. Gather the children in the middle of the playing area.
3. Read out a statement. If the children think the statement is true, they move to the one side and if they think the statement is false, they move to the other side.
4. If they are incorrect, they are out and have to sit down.
5. Have the children move back to the middle and read the next statement.
6. Last person standing is the winner.

Statement examples: (These could be theme specific or just random)

- Killer whales are part of the dolphin family – True.
- Russia is a continent – False.
- Like fingerprints, everyone has a unique tongue print – True.
- A shark is the only fish that can blink with both eyes – True.
- Dreamt is the only English word to end with the letters “mt” – True.
- Jesus was 28 when He started His ministry – False. He was 30.
- There are 60 books in the Bible – False. There are 66.
- Psalm 117 is the shortest chapter in the Bible – True. It is 2 verses long.
