Both disobeyed God. What was the punishment? It was death. Because of their sin they couldn't have life with God anymore.




But the story didn't end their!



LESSON 2: Victory only through Jesus.

Sin is thinking, doing or saying something wrong. Sin is anything that goes against God. Adam and Eve were the first to sin but they were NOT the last. Every one of us have sinned too.


Can you think of sins you have done?

If we have sin we cannot have life with God. Many years ago God told His people that He would send a saviour or Messiah that would come and save the world. To make sure there was no mistaking who this was, God also sent about 355 prophecies (or messages) telling us exactly what the promised one would be like. 

LESSON 3: Jesus died and came alive

God's plan to save us started when Jesus came to earth. Some of the leaders at the time didn't like Jesus. They thought He was lying about being God's son and they wanted to kill Him.



Jesus's friend, Judas, told the leaders that he would help them arrest Jesus and they paid him.




After they had arrested Jesus, they beat Him, spat on Him and put a crown made of thorns on His head.

Then they made Jesus carry a heavy wooden cross up the hill. Jesus was very tired, and His body was sore and broken. He struggled to carry the cross and He needed help.

They put big nails through Jesus's hands and feet and hung Him on a cross.

Jesus knew that He needed to die so that we could all be forgiven of our sins.





When Jesus died the curtain in the temple tore. That meant that anyone could go in and talk to God. That means no matter where you are, you can talk to God. A man named Joseph took Jesus' body and buried Him. This seems like a sad story. How is this God's perfect plan to save us? But look what happened next!





3 days after Jesus had died some women went to His grave, but they were very surprised when they got there.

JESUS WAS GONE! They saw an angel and the angel told them that **Jesus had come back to life**. He wasn't dead anymore.


They were so happy that they ran back to tell everyone!

LESSON 4: Victory over fear

What are you afraid of? Draw these in the block




It doesn't feel nice being afraid. But did you know it says in the Bible 365 times **"Do not be afraid"**. There are also 365 days in 1 year. That means God is telling us every day not to be afraid. The Bibles says in 2 Timothy 1:7



Knowing that fear is not from God and it's not His plan for us will help to not be afraid anymore.

Pray and ask God to help you not be afraid anymore:

Ephesians 6:10-18 tells us that God has given us a special kind of armour. It's not made of metal but instead it is a spiritual armour. We can't see it with our eyes, but it is real. It protects us and helps us fight against our fears and the lies of the enemy.






The Helmet of Salvation helps keep our thoughts on God all the time.

The Breastplate of Righteousness is Jesus Himself helping us stay without sin.



The Belt of Truth is us following Jesus because He is the truth. Lies from the enemy are easy to see when you know Truth (Truth (1997)) The truth.

The Shoes of the Gospel of Peace are put on our feet so that we are always ready to go and tell someone about Jesus.





The Shield of Faith is what protects us. Faith means to believe in God's promises. We know God has promised to take care of us and never leave us. When we believe these promises and have faith we are protected from the lies of the enemy.

The Sword of the Spirit is the Word of God, the Bible. If we know what the Bible says, even when we are tricked or tempted to do bad things, we will be able to fight back and say no. Can you label the picture without looking?




LESSON 5: Victory over temptation

Tempted means thinking about doing something even when you know it is wrong.

Have you ever been tempted to tell a lie, or take something that isn't yours? Doing these things would be sinning. God loves us even if we do these things and He will forgive us **BUT** he wants us to try our best not to give into these temptations.

Did you know that Jesus was also tempted when He lived on earth? But He did not sin.

Jesus used the sword of the spirit which is the WORD OF GOD (Bible) to make sure He didn't sin.



Matthew 4 tells us that the Holy Spirit led Jesus to the desert and Jesus hadn't eaten or drunk something for 40 days!

Satan tempted Jesus and said "If you are the Son of God then why don't you just turn these stones into bread?"





But Jesus knew that was not what God's word said **so Jesus did not sin!**

Next satan took Jesus to the top of a very high temple and

said, "If you are the Son of God, just jump and surely the angels will catch you. It even says in the scriptures that God will send His angels to protect you and you won't even hit your foot on a rock!"





But Jesus knew he shouldn't jump because the Bible said do not test God and **so Jesus did not sin!**


Satan tried to tempt Jesus again. This time by offering Him wealth and power and all Jesus had to do was bow and worship satan.

Jesus shouted, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written, 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only." Again **Jesus did not sin!**



Finally, satan left Jesus alone.

Jesus walked out of the desert and began His ministry. What a VICTORY! Jesus had faced temptation but did not sin.



LESSON 6: Victory through faith

God told a man named Joshua about a great plan He had. God wanted Joshua to go to battle against the city of Jericho.



Jericho was a very big city with very high walls and lots of strong warriors.

Joshua thought what God was asking him to do was impossible and he was scared.

But God told Joshua that before he even started to fight, he was going to win. God was going to make him win! Joshua loved God and he had faith that if God said they were going to win then they would.

When the city of Jericho heard the Israelite army was coming to fight against them, they closed their city gates. They were so scared. The people of Jericho didn't love and




obey God but they knew that God was much stronger than their big walls and army!

God told Joshua to tell the Israelite army to march around the city of Jericho once, every day for six days. On day 7 God told them to march around the city 7 times. This time He said the priests must blow their horns and the people must shout as loud as they could and the walls would then fall down.



God heard their shout and all the walls fell down! God had helped them win the battle - just like He said He would. Joshua trusted God. He had faith and they had won.

Just like Joshua we need to trust God. He knows what is best. He will always give us the victory.

LESSON 7: God is always with us

Sometimes God asks us to do things for Him and we feel like it is too hard or too scary.

He asks us to tell others about Jesus.

He asks us to read the Bible so we can teach others what it says.

He asks us to pray for miracles.

Remember you can do these things because God is with you ALL the time.


Let's learn about a man named Gideon. (Judges 6 and 7) who got scared when God asked him to do something.

God had done so many miracles for the Israelite people and looked after them so well **but** they stopped loving God. They didn't follow His rules and started loving gods that were not real. God let the Midianite army steal all their food and cows and the people had to hide in caves because they were scared.



It took the Israelites 7 years for them to see how much they needed God's help. They begged God to help them. God is so forgiving. He had a plan to save them!

God sent Gideon a message. He wanted him to fight the Midianite army. Gideon was scared but God **promised to be with him**.



Gideon got 32 000 men to be part of his army. God told Gideon to make his army smaller. God wanted to make sure they knew it was God who would win the fight and not them. So, Gideon told anyone who was feeling scared to go home! Only 10 000 men stayed.

Again, God told Gideon that the army was **too big**. God told Gideon to tell the men who drank out of the river without using their hands to go home. Now only 300 men were left!

Gideon was scared that they would lose this battle with only 300 men against the 135000 Midianite men!





God sent Gideon into the Midianite camp to hear them talking.

The soldiers were scared because they dreamt that a big loaf of bread came rolling through the camp and squashed them all. They knew God was going to help the Israelites win the fight.

Gideon was so excited that he ran back to his men praising God all the way!

On the day of the fight God told them to break clay pots, wave lights, blow trumpets and shout "FOR GOD AND FOR GIDEON!" The Midianite men were so scared they started to fight each other! The Israelites won!



David said to Goliath, "You come at me with a sword, but I come to you in the name of the Lord almighty!" He knew that God was on his side and that God would give him victory in this battle.






And God did help him! The stone hit Goliath in the head

Jesus was travelling from place to place teaching people about God and how they should live. And where was Mary?


She was right there **with**

Before James and John knew and loved Jesus their lives were very different from afterwards. Can you see the difference?


