(Be Thankful)

Lesson Idea:

What a difference it makes when we focus on the things we have instead of the things we don't have.

1 Thessalonians 5:18

Children could sit in a circle. The dice below has different colours on each side. Each child has a turn to throw the dice and then refers to the key. Name one thing you are grateful for each time you roll the dice.

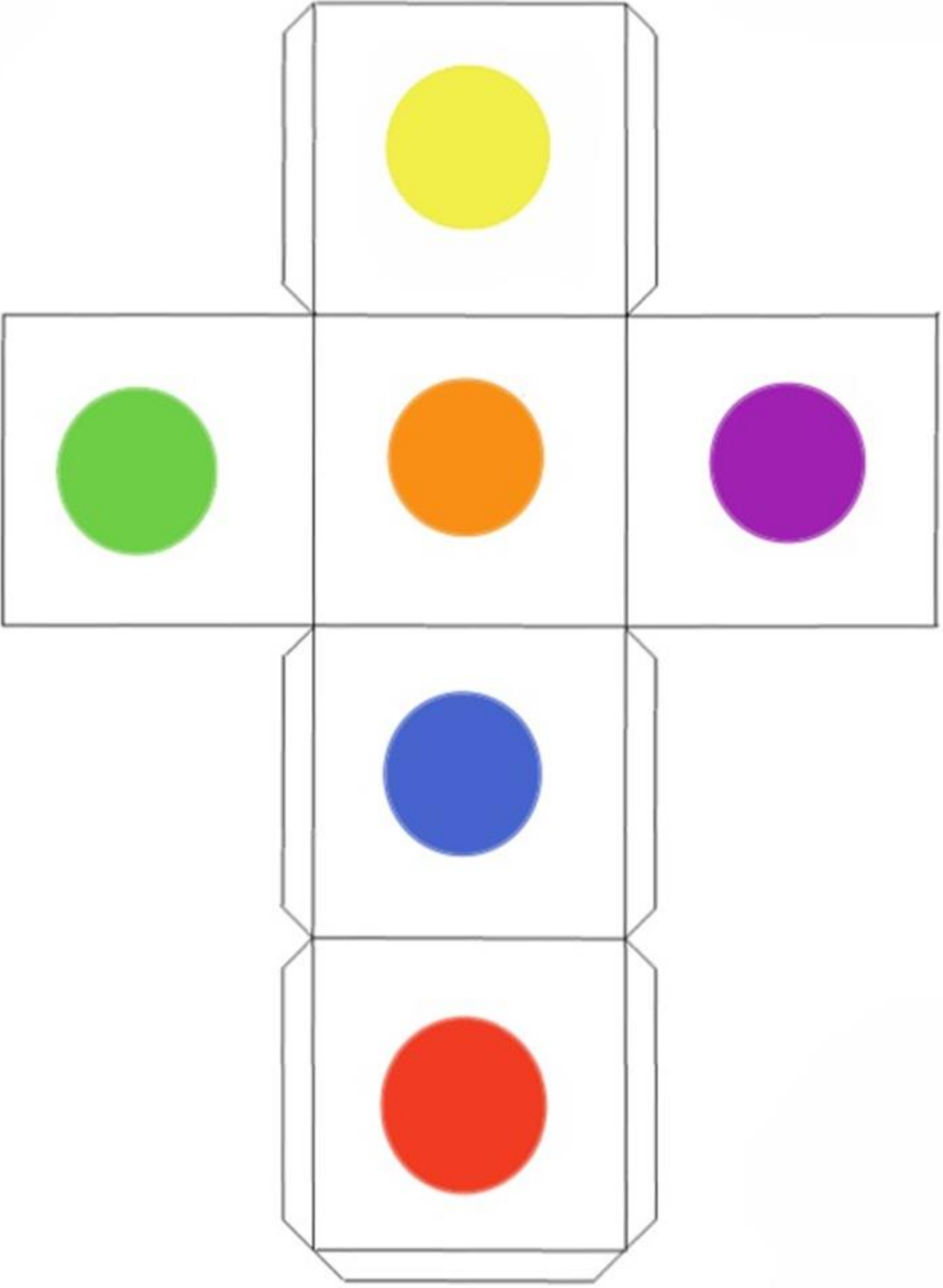
Items needed per child:

- A dice template (PDF included below)
- Glue
- Scissors

Craft making instructions:

1. Cut around the outside of the template, not on the inner lines.
2. Fold along the inner lines to form the shape of a cube.
3. Put glue on the tabs to hold the dice together. Little ones will need help.



Give thanks to the Lord!

Roll the dice and name one thing that you are thankful for according to the colour rolled

Green: Something that God created that you are thankful for.

Orange: A person that you are thankful for.

Purple: Something that God has given you that you are thankful for.

Blue: Something at Children's church that you are thankful for.

Yellow: Something that God has done that you are thankful for.

Red: Something at school that you are thankful for.
