

Spinning Wheel!

(Love is)

Lesson Idea:

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

⁴Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud ⁵or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. ⁶It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. ⁷Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

The Bible not only encourages us but in fact commands us to love. Use the spinner wheel to help children understand and learn what it actually means to love. Wow! Only Jesus is able to love in such a perfect way, but we should always try our best to follow His example.

Items needed per child:

- Template of front and back of spinning wheel
- Split pin

Craft making instructions:

1. Print the two circles, the front and under layer, exactly the same size.
2. Cut a gap in the front cover. Be careful to not cut all the way to the middle, as you will need somewhere to poke the split pin through.
3. Pierce the split pin through both layers. Moving one of the layers will reveal each new picture or word.
