

Swivel Cup Face!

Lesson Idea:

Can you imagine the emotions that the people who encountered Jesus must have experienced? Imagine being blind and being made to see again? Or not being able to walk and then being able to leap up and run? Well this clever craft is a way to tell the story and show the emotions of the people at the same time.



You can use this craft as you tell the story of the man born blind, the tax collector, the unforgiving servant or any other story you may choose.

Items needed per child:

- 2 paper cups
- Scissors, koki pens
- Bottle decorated like a person

Craft making instructions:

1. Cut eye and mouth holes out of one of the cups.
2. Decorate the other cup with the two or three different emotions that you need for telling the story. E.g. blind eyes and seeing eyes, sad face, scared face and happy face.
3. Slip the cut cup over the decorated cup so that as you twist the cups and tell the story, the face changes.
4. You could choose to put the cups on top of a bottle decorated like a person for an even better story telling effect.
5. You could have different size bottles and use them to tell the story of David and Goliath or even Joseph's life.
6. Children can recreate this craft and take it home to retell the story to their friends and families!
