Quack Quack Craft! (Nativity – Promises fulfilled)

Lesson Idea:

Let your children have fun with this little "Quack quack" as they practice answering questions about the birth and life of Jesus. Each of these questions can help our children see that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies, or promises, that God made about the Saviour that would come to give us eternal life.


Items needed per child:

"Quack quack" Nativity template

Craft making instructions (see pictures below)

- 1. First make sure you are working with a square piece of paper. Cut it if necessary. Little ones may need your help following the folding instructions.
- 2. Fold on the diagonals so that you have four triangles.
- 3. Fold each corner towards the middle.
- 4. Turn over the square now.
- 5. Again, fold the corners to the middle of the square.
- 6. Now pull out the corners to make pockets for your fingertips to fit into.



How to use the "quack quack" craft:

- 1. Start by choosing one of the four nativity characters. So, if you choose "Mary" you have to open and close your fingers while spelling out "M-A-R-Y"
- 2. Next, choose one of the numbers on the inside layer that you have stopped on. So, if it's "5" you open and close your fingers five times.
- 3. Lastly, choose another number and open it up to reveal the question and answer inside.
- 4. Play with friends or family.
