## TEACHER NOTES

- Get the children excited as you show them the items. Each item or picture will have a verse on it.
- EVIDENCE 1
  - Crown – Who wears one of these? This crown has a verse on it. What does that verse say?
  - Name tag - Our name tags say who we are. This name tag shows us three things about God can you work out that they are?
  - Globe keyring – What do you think this keyring tells us?
- Allocate each of the children one of the verses to look up and tell the group what they have found about God. If needed use the verses over the page.
- They will use these verses to fill in the missing words.
- Briefly explain each clue as per teacher notes on the next page.

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## TEACHER NOTES

- CROWN: Psalm 10:16 (King)

God is a King like no other because He is the King forever and ever!

- NAME TAG: Deuteronomy 32:4 (Perfect)

How many times do you get 100% for a test? Do you get 100% for *every* test? Well God is perfect. Everything He says and does is perfect. He is perfect 100% of the time.

- NAME TAG: Psalm 96:9 (Holy)

God is Holy. That means that He is unique and set apart from all else because He is perfect in goodness and has never done anything wrong.

- NAME TAG: 1 John 3:1 (Father)

God is your Father. He is not like just any father. Like we have already discovered, He is our perfect and holy Father. And He loves us and calls us His children.

- GLOBE KEYRING: Genesis 1:1 (Earth) 1 Corinthians 8:6

Who made the stars? (*God*) The planets? (*God*) The flowers? (*God*)

Who made that tree ...? *Name things around you.* And who made you? *God*  
Who does the evidence say God is? *God is the creator of the heavens and the earth. God is the creator of everything!*

- **If you want to find God, look for Him in creation around you and look in the Bible.**
- **If you look you will find God is our perfect, Holy Father who created everything.**

## TEACHER NOTES

- People who were there and have seen something happen are able to tell you what happened. We call this their testimony. The Bible is full of testimonies of people who witnessed God's miracles and the life of Jesus.
- EVIDENCE 2: *Use dress up items.* Choose a volunteer to "tell" (read) their testimony of God providing manna from Heaven.
- What did God provide? *Bread.* From hearing their testimony, we find that God gives us everything we need.
- This and the many other testimonies from the Bible tell us so much about God.
- John 6:51 is Jesus speaking. Jesus' testimony is perfect and the best way we can find God and who He is.
- This is what Jesus was saying.
  - John 6:51 - Jesus said "I am the living bread that came down from Heaven"

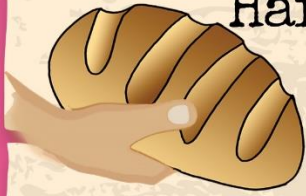
Did you know that "I am" is one of God's names? By saying "**I am** the bread of life" He is telling them that He is God.

- John 6:51 - Jesus said "Whoever eats this bread will **live forever**" Jesus says when we believe that He died and came alive for our sins, and accept Him as our Savior, then we will have eternal life with Him.
- **If you want to find God, look for Him in the testimonies of others.**
- **If you look you will find that God gives us everything we need.**

## TEACHER NOTES

- Jesus said this (John 6:51) straight after He did a miracle to feed 5000 people. He used a boy's small lunch of bread and fish. Once everyone was fed there were 12 baskets leftover.
- When the people were hungry, God gave them bread. God gave them everything they needed. God gives us the physical things we need.
- Jesus said these things because He wanted the people to understand that we can trust Him for the physical things we need and more importantly, that He gives us everlasting life with Him in Heaven.
- **If you want to find God, look for Him in the testimony of Jesus.**
- **If you look you will find Jesus gives us eternal life which no one else can.**

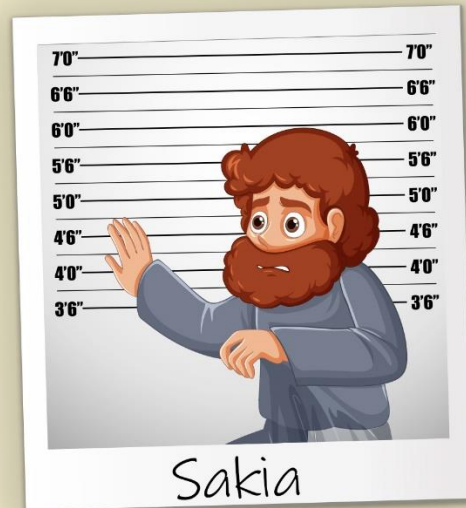

## TEACHER NOTES

- The Bible tells us that no one loves God perfectly as He deserves to be loved. In fact, we all have done things that go against God. We call this sin. Every one of us have sinned. The punishment for sin is separation from God. We cannot have eternal life with God in Heaven if we have sinned.

<sup>23</sup> For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Romans 3:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

- Zacchaeus stole money and so people hated him and didn't want to be near him. (Luke 19:1-10)

Did he deserve punishment? *Yes*

What did Jesus do? *Forgave him*

- Jesus did not do even one thing wrong. He **never** sinned. Not even once!

Did He deserve punishment? *NO!*

Yet, Jesus allowed them to kill him on the cross so that our sins could be forgiven. Jesus took our punishment for us.

## WHAT THE CHILDREN DO:

- Answer YES to the question "Did Zacchaeus do something wrong?"
- Answer YES to the question "Did Jesus forgive him?"

## TEACHER NOTES

- EVIDENCE 3: Crime scene photo (Tomb)  
Can you see what is missing from this photo? *Jesus!*  
Jesus was killed on the cross and His body was placed in a tomb but three days later the tomb was empty!
- Read 1 Corinthians 15:4. Jesus did not stay dead.
- Look up 2 Corinthians 5:21 and discuss the following:

<sup>21</sup> For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

- Have you ever done something wrong? *Yes, we have all sinned.*  
Do you deserve punishment? *Yes, and the punishment for sin is separation from God. No eternal life with Him.*
- Why did Jesus die on the cross if He had done nothing wrong? *Jesus was the offering. That means He took on our sin and died in our place. What He did means the punishment we deserve has been paid for by Him.*
- Has Jesus forgiven you? The Bible says if we ask Jesus to forgive us He will.  
If we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. 1 John 1:9
- **If you look you will find JESUS IS ALIVE!**

## WHAT THE CHILDREN DO:

- Look up 1 Corinthians 15:4 to answer “Yes, Jesus is alive!”
- Look up 2 Corinthians 5:21 to answer the questions
  - 1) Did Jesus ever sin? “No”
  - 2) Have you ever sinned? “Yes” (We all have)
  - 3) Why did Jesus die on the cross? “It was always God’s plan to save us from our sin, Jesus sacrificed His life for us to be with God in Heaven.

## TEACHER NOTES

- EVIDENCE 4 – Heart and footprint
- The Bible is filled with advice and warnings on how to live. The Bible leads us away from sin and towards living a life that pleases God.
- God wants us to hide His Word in our hearts. This is like God is saying “know what My message is to you and know it so well so that you can always be led to make good choices.”
- God has also given us the Holy Spirit who lives in us. The Holy Spirit helps us in so many ways. These include reminding us and teaching us what the Bible says. The Holy Spirit is also given to lead and guide us.
- **If you want to find God, look for Him in the Bible**
- **If you want to find God, look for Him as the Holy Spirit reminds and guides you.**
- **If you look you will find God leads us.**

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## TEACHER NOTES
