

God is the Perfect Judge

Lesson learnt:

This object lesson teaches the children about fairness and unfairness. It demonstrates to the children that because God is a fair God He sent His son Jesus to pay the price for our sins.

Items needed:

- A balance-scale
- Empty toilet rolls wrapped in words like "worry", "People", "I can't", "tough times"
- A bunch of heavy objects in a bag like beads or stones.
- A mini (very small) action-figure to represent us.

Instructions:

- 1)
- 2) Leader 1: Begin by saying, "We need to peel these bananas before we eat them."
- 3) Leader 2: (take a bite of it with the peel still on)- "Gross, I should have listened and done what I was told, I should have peeled the banana."
- 4) Leader 1: "Yes you should of" (they then peel theres and take a bite) Then state to the children that just like leader 2 should have listened and peeled the banana, in the same way we must listen to God's word and then we must actually do it! In James 1:22 it says "don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says."
