Moses then spent time with God and he saw God...








Exodus 33:11 Much later when Moses spoke to God in the tent it was not the same. How did he now speak to God?


God wants you to speak to Him like a friend.








Naaman was desperate and travelled a long way to find Elisha, God's prophet. Elisha told Naaman what to do - and Naaman was not happy!











Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my Light and my Salvation, so why should I be afraid?

God chose people to go and tell others His message.


These people are called PROPERS.

Did the men choose to obey King Nebuchadnezzar or God, the King of everything?




