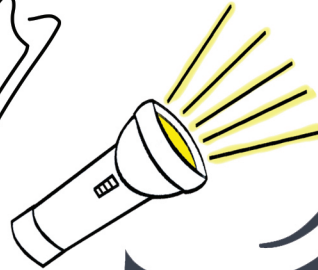

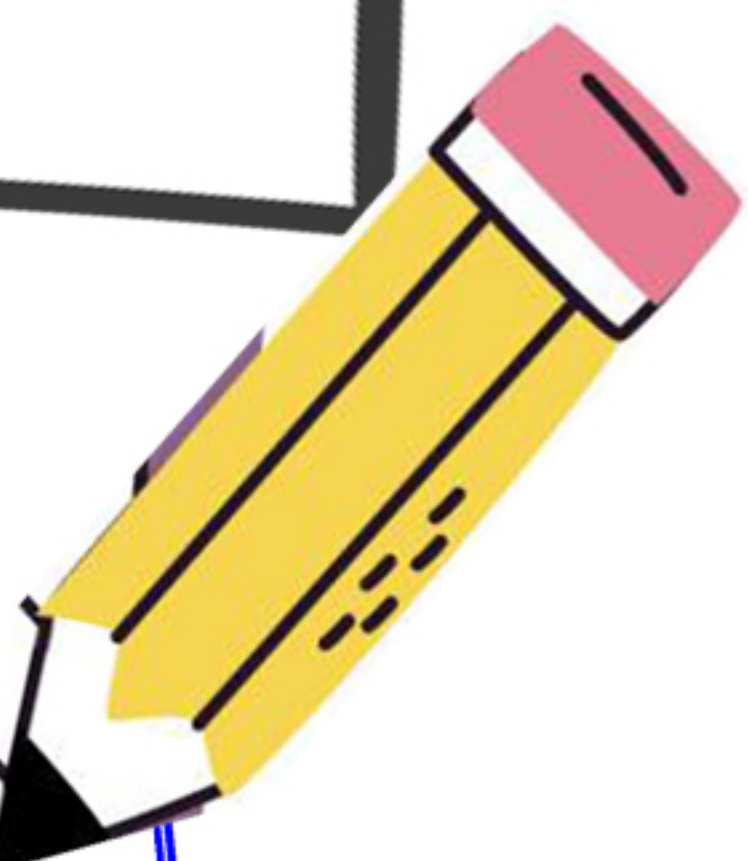

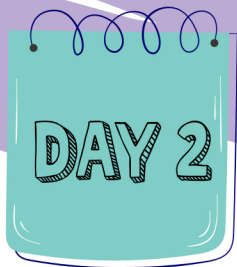
Joseph did not punish his brothers, instead he

Naaman was desperate and travelled a long way to find Elisha, God's prophet. Elisha told Naaman what to do - and Naaman was not happy!

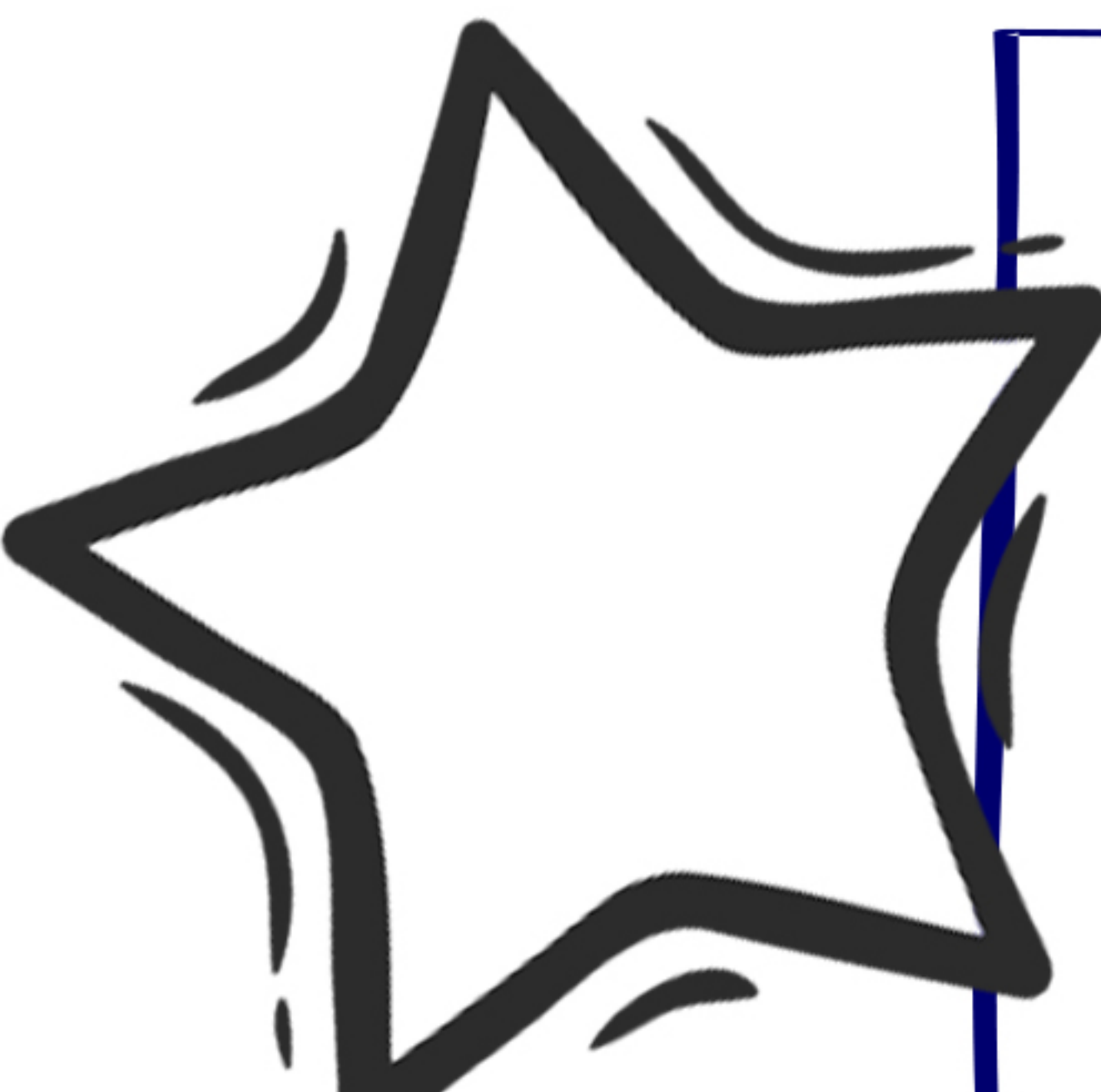

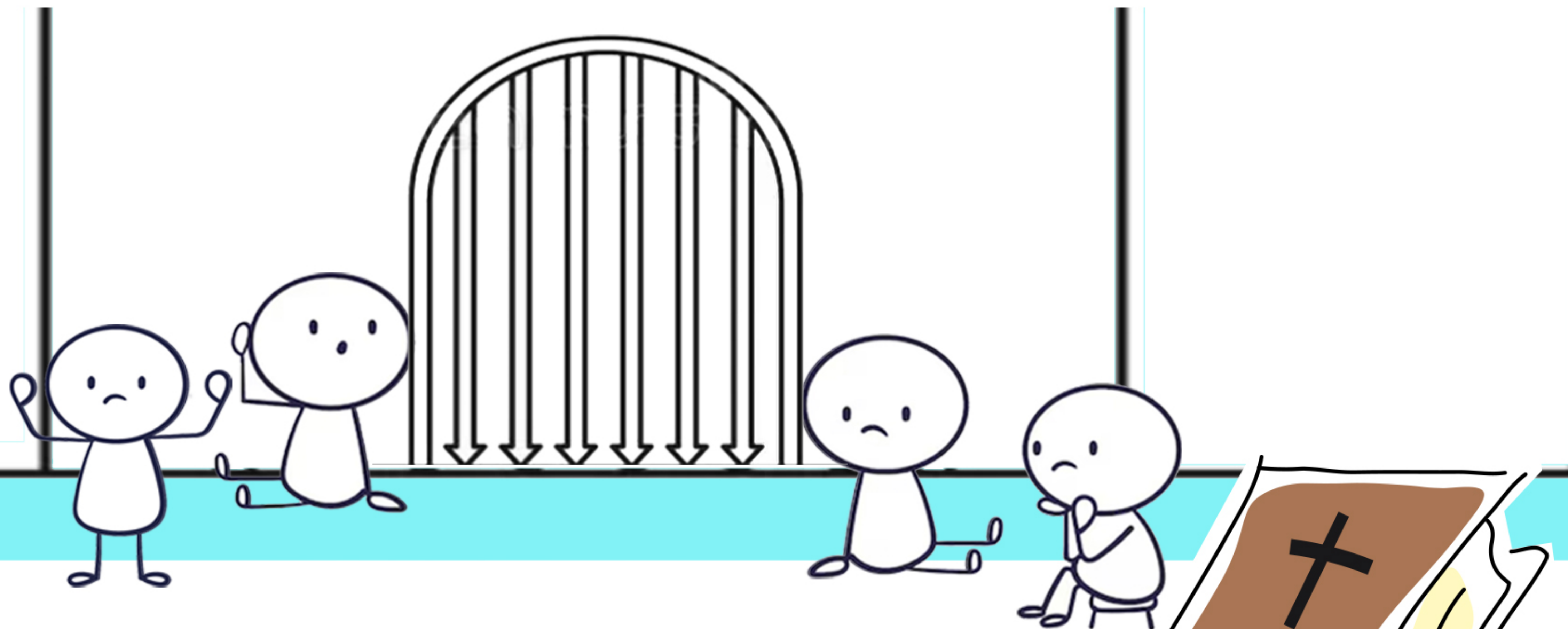


DAY 4

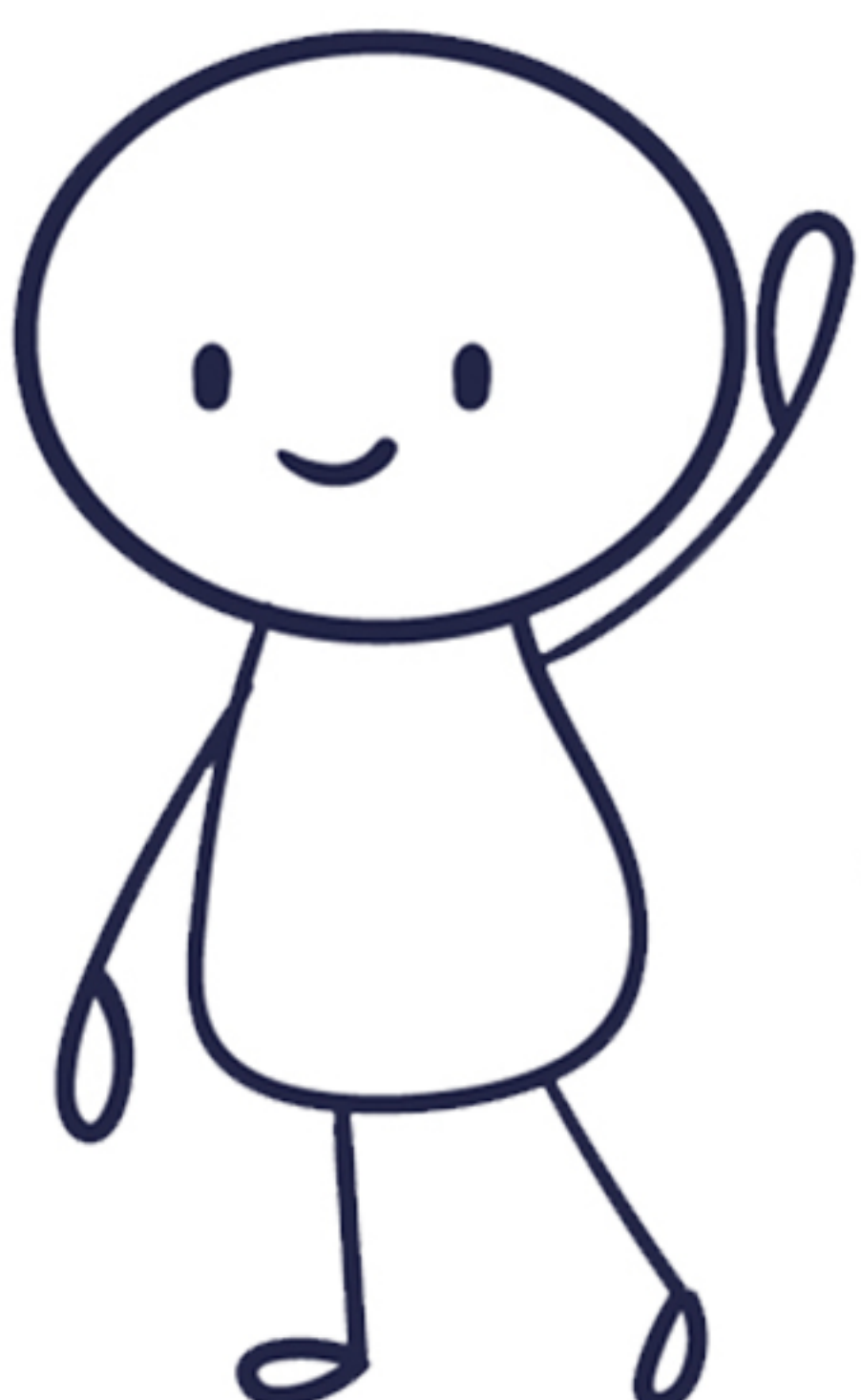
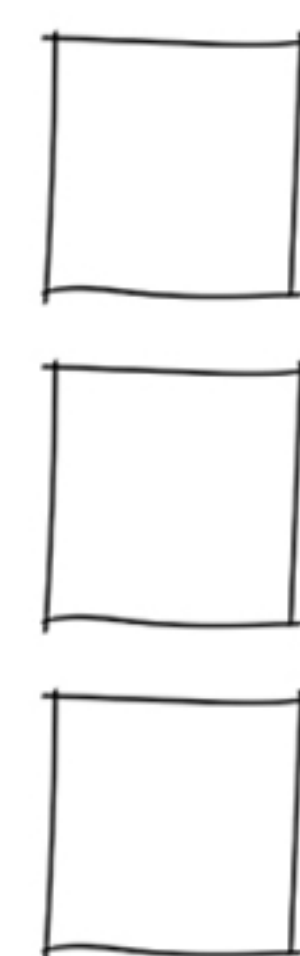
In verse 9 what did they decide to do?

Why? Because God is the One who saves us. And we can put our trust in Him.

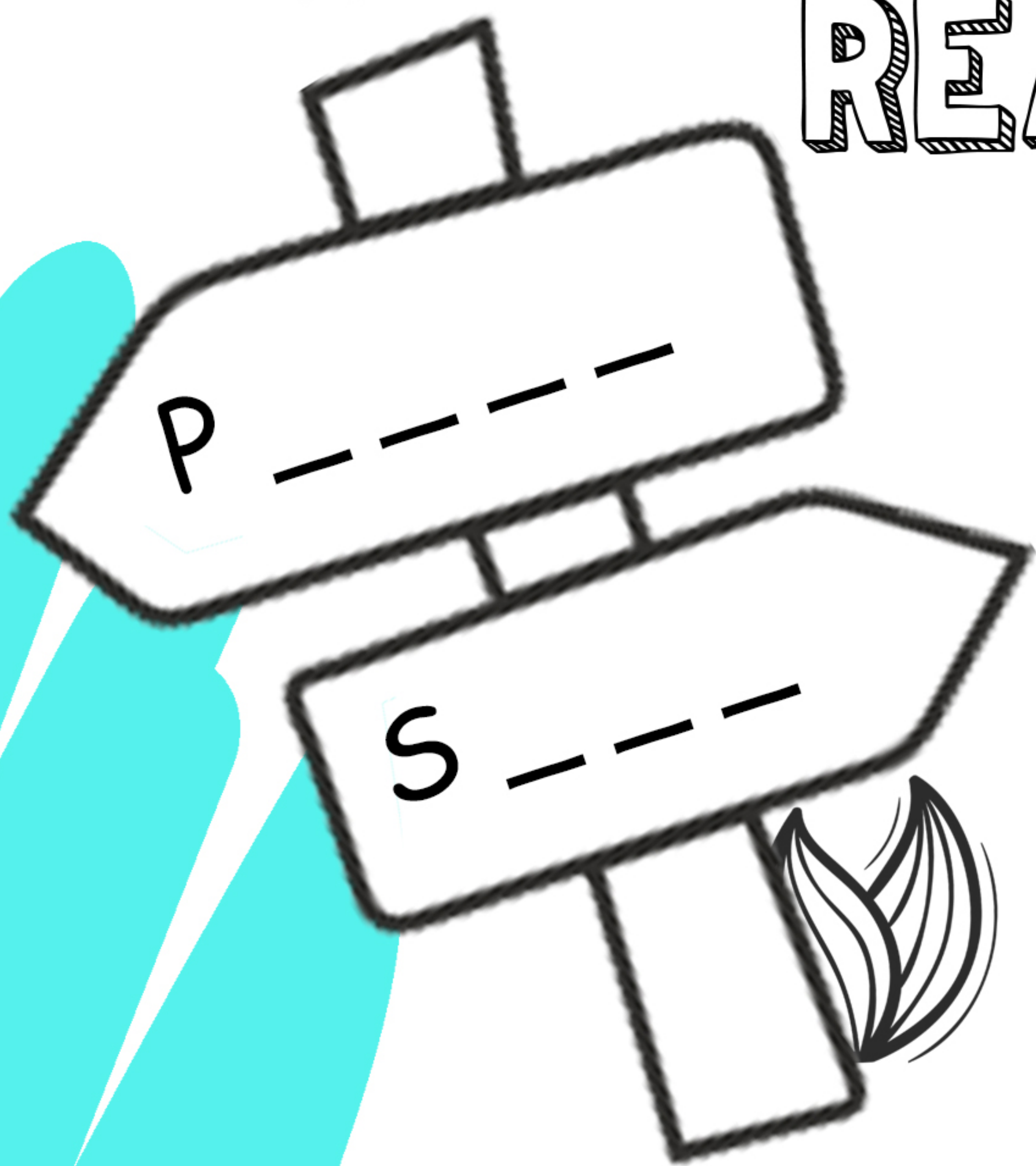

God chose people to go and tell others His message.

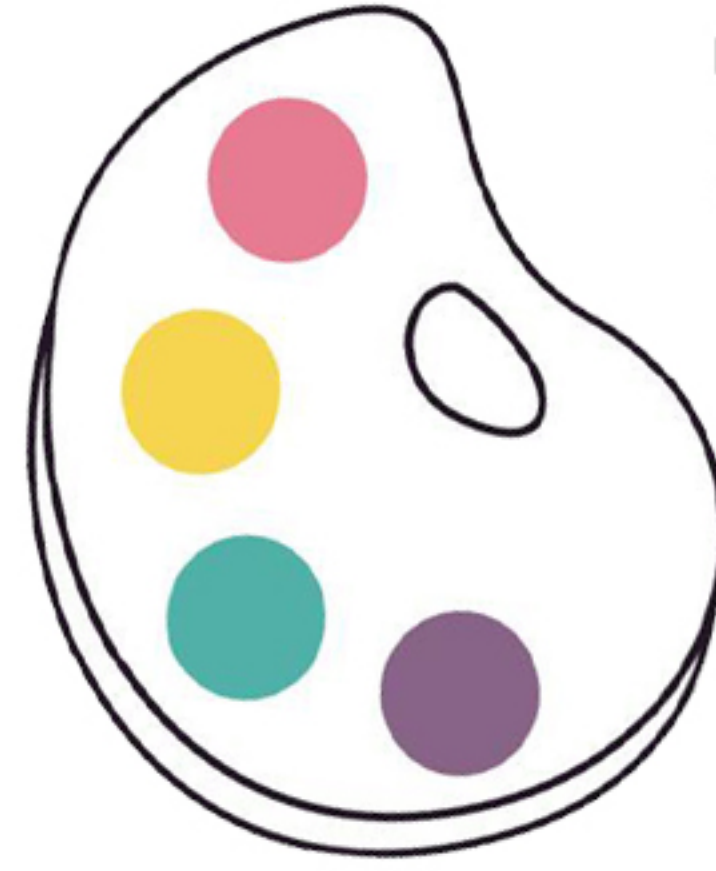
These people are called **PROPHETS**.
