Then the Lord said to Elijah, "Go to the east and hide by Kerith Brook, near where it enters the Jordan River." 1 Kings 17:2-4





"Drink from the brook and eat what the ravens bring you, for I have commanded them to bring you food." 1 Kings 17:2-4

Craft option 2:

Follow the trail and use your Bible to find out Elijah's story.

The maze consists of 16 circular nodes, each containing an illustration and a Bible verse. The trail starts at the top left node and winds through the maze to the bottom right node.

Node 1 (Top Left): She said to Elijah, "O man of God, what have you done to me? Have you come here to point out my sins and kill my son?" 1 Kings 17:18

Node 2 (Top Middle-Left): Then Elijah cried out to the Lord, "O Lord my God, why have you brought tragedy to this widow who has opened her home to me, causing her son to die?" 1 Kings 17:20

Node 3 (Top Middle-Right): The Lord heard Elijah's prayer, and the life of the child returned, and he revived! 1 Kings 17:22

Node 4 (Top Right): Then the woman told Elijah, "Now I know for sure that you are a man of God, and that the Lord truly speaks through you!" 1 Kings 17:24

Node 5 (Middle Left): 1 Kings 17:20

Node 6 (Middle Middle-Left): 1 Kings 17:22

Node 7 (Middle Middle-Right): 1 Kings 17:24

Node 8 (Middle Right): 1 Kings 17:18

Node 9 (Bottom Left): 1 Kings 17:17

Node 10 (Bottom Middle-Left): 1 Kings 17:19

Node 11 (Bottom Middle-Right): 1 Kings 17:21

Node 12 (Bottom Right): 1 Kings 17:23

Node 13 (Bottom Left): Some time later the woman's son became sick. He grew worse and worse, and finally he died. 1 Kings 17:17

Node 14 (Bottom Middle-Left): Elijah replied, "Give me your son." And he took the child's body from her arms, carried him up the stairs to the room where he was staying, and laid the body on his bed. 1 Kings 17:19

Node 15 (Bottom Middle-Right): Elijah stretched himself out over the child three times and cried out to the Lord, "O Lord my God, please let this child's life return to him." 1 Kings 17:21

Node 16 (Bottom Right): Then Elijah brought him down from the upper room and gave him to his mother. "Look!" he said. "Your son is alive!" 1 Kings 17:23

Elijah cried out to God, asking why this had happened.



Elijah said, "Give me your son," and took him upstairs.



The woman was upset and asked Elijah why this had happened.



The woman's son became very sick and then he died.



Elijah prayed three times "God, please bring him back to life."



God heard Elijah's prayer, and the boy came back to life!



The woman said, "Now I know you are a man of God, and God truly speaks through you."
