Guess what

Lesson Idea: We need to ask Jesus, the one who knows, for help and He will guide us so that we get it right and know what to say, when to say it, and who to say it to. We also used this verse, **Psalm 25:4 says**, "Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow."

Items needed:

We used 2 sets of 4 different items

- X2 slinky
- X2 mini skateboard
- X2 mini croc shoes
- X2 mini globe
- X2 box/shelf (To hide the items on a box/shelf and set up another box/shelf for the children to use.)

Game instructions:

- 1. To play the game, the leader puts the items in a specific order on the hidden shelf. The children then go one by one to move the items however they want to see if they can put them in the matching order of the items the leader has hidden.
- Once they have taken a guess at the order, the leader simply says if it is correct or not. No clues are given. Continue the game until the order is correct. Once they guess the correct order, reset the hidden items and start over.
- 3. We used this to show them that if they wanted to get the order correct the first time they should have asked the one who knows. If you had asked the leader, they would have directed the child correctly on their first try. Sometimes we may actually get it right but we will always get it right if we ask Jesus to help us. He will help you know what to say, when to say it and even who to say it to. The best way we can help others know and love Jesus is to ask Jesus for help.
