Guess where

Lesson Idea: If we don't ask God for guidance, we may guess and get things wrong, but when we ask Him where to go, what to do, and what to say, we'll get it right every time. We also used this verse, **Psalm 25:4 says**, "Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow."

<u>Items needed:</u>

- a long rectangular box
- a few corrugated boards measured to patch the top of the box
- some small balloons
- kebab sticks.

Game instructions:

- 1. Without the children seeing (they face the other way) place the balloon in the box.
- 2. Each child has a turn to poke their stick through the box to see if they can pop the balloon even though they do not know where it is.
- 3. We used this to show the children if you are not asking God where to go, who to speak to, and even what to say; it is like trying to poke this small balloon without knowing where it is. Of course, sometimes we might get it right, but if the child had asked the leader where the balloon was, they would have gotten it right every time. In the same way when we ask God for help, and follow His directions, we will get it right every time.
