Craft option 1:

For the **Mighty** One is **holy**, and He has done **great** things for me.


He shows **mercy** from generation to generation to all who fear Him.







Hannah prayed so passionately that Eli thought she was drunk. She explained that she was pouring her heart out to God.




Hannah trusted God and had peace

Samuel went to live in the temple.


