God told the Israelites to paint the blood of a perfect lamb on their doors. By doing this they were saved from Egypt.

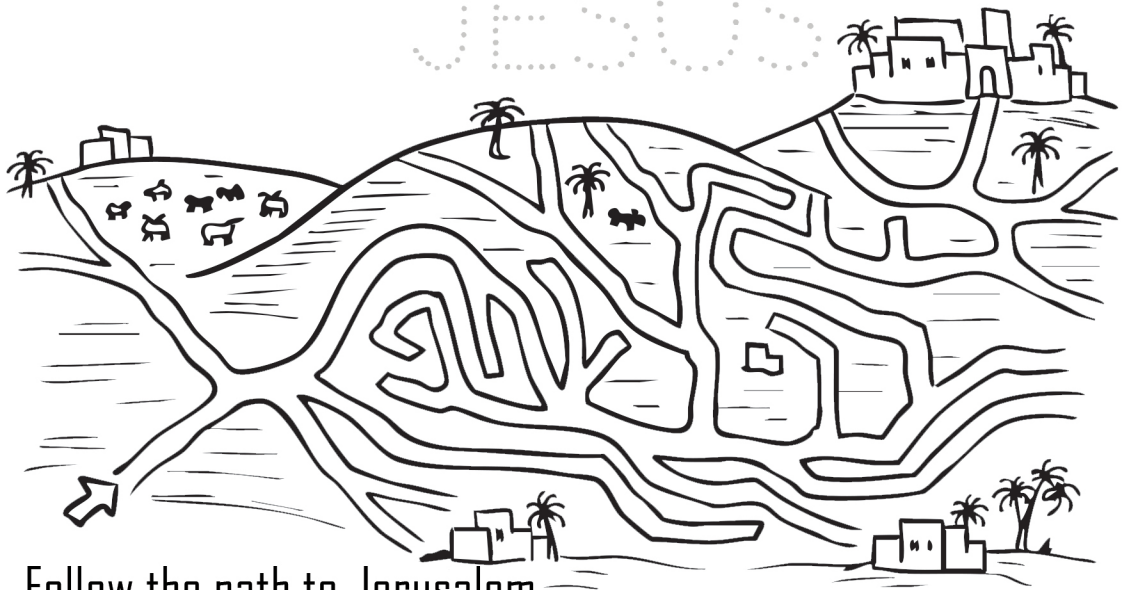
Year after year the nation of Israel would travel to Jerusalem and have a Passover Feast to remember how God had saved them.
