The shepherds hurried to Bethlehem and found Mary, Joseph, and the baby who was lying in a manger.





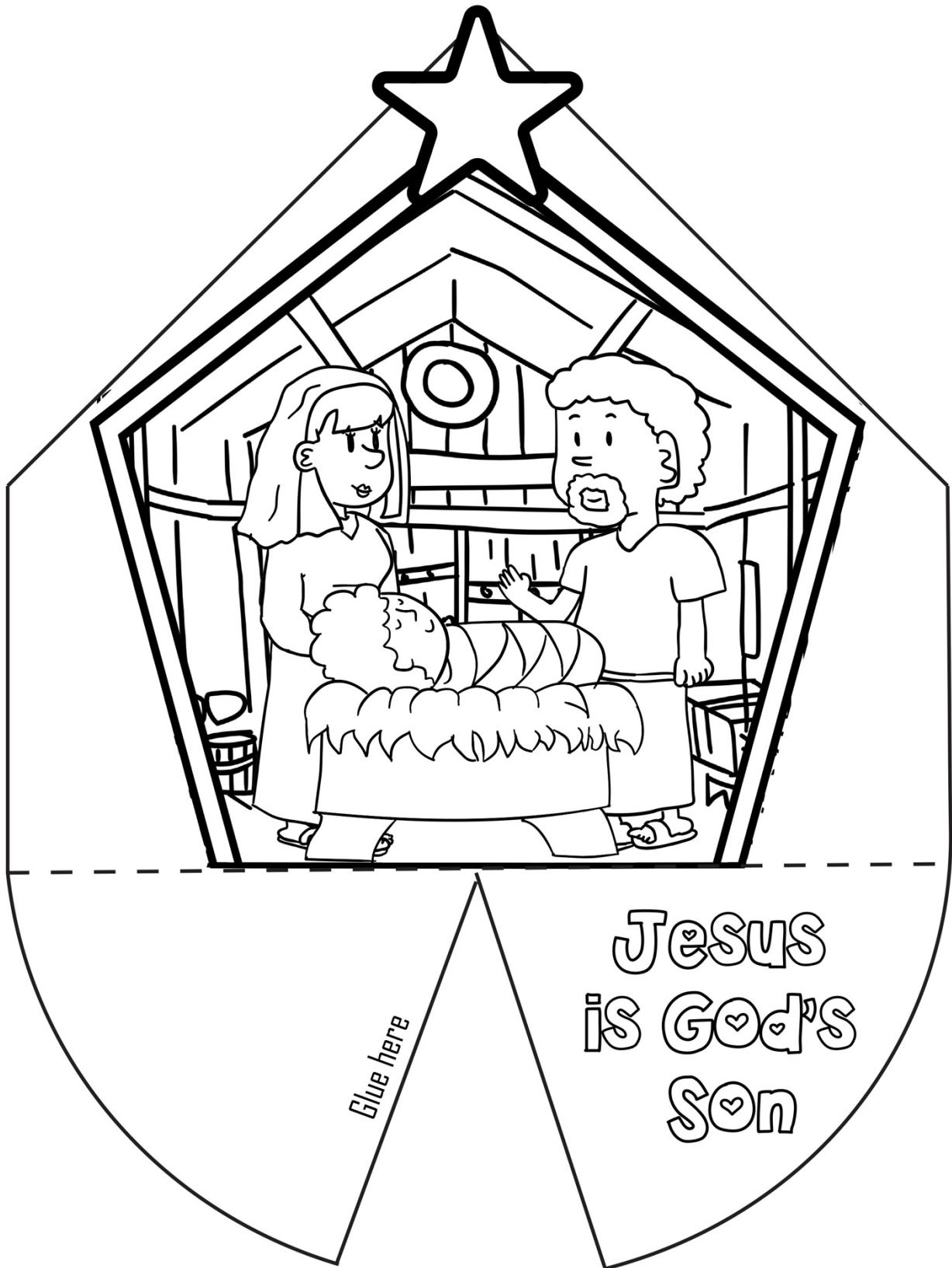
About two years later, wise men came from the East. They had seen a star

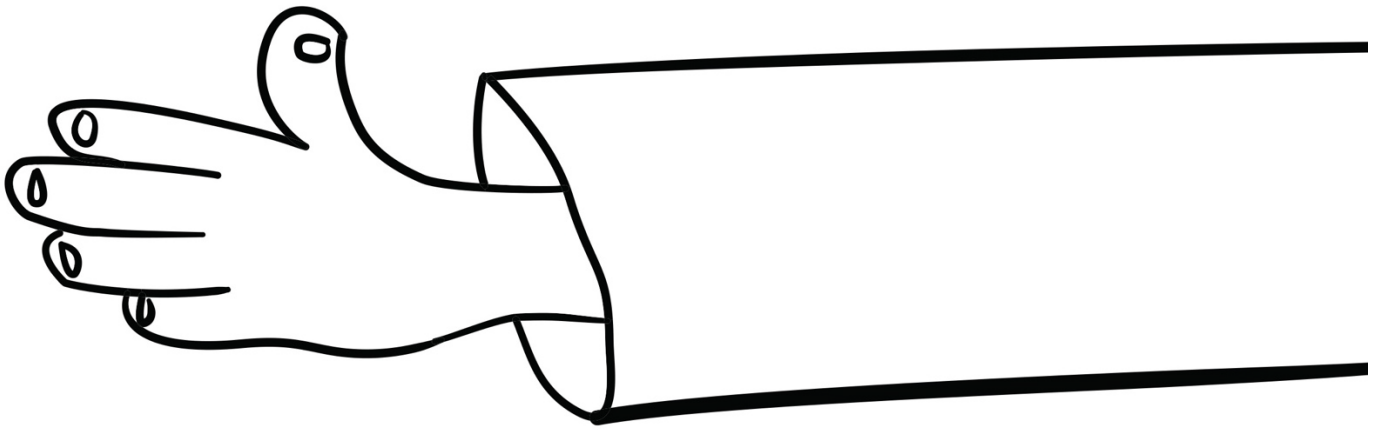
How to use the "quack quack" craft:

- 1) Cut out the cross with JESUS on it and set it aside.
- 2) Fold the rest of the page in half horizontally along the central dotted line.
- 3) Cut along the other four dotted lines.
- 4) Unfold the page to 90 degrees so that the top of the page stands up. Push the cliff parts of to picture forward and invert the folds so that they stand out.
- 5) Put a little glue on the marked grey spots and stick the cross across the space between "me" and "God".
